Waiver of Immunizations (Maine)

The State of ME requires campers and camp staff to provide A record of immunizations, including the date of last tetanus shot, and available information concerning age specific vaccinations such as: Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Haemophilus influenza Type b, Hepatitis B, Varicell, Pneumococcal, Rotavirus, Hepatitis A or C, Human Papillomavirus, Meningococcal, Influenza, TB Mantoux Test. Maine State Regs (MSR) 144c208 5.B.a.3

A camper or camp staff may be exempted by this statute in accordance with (MSR) 144c208 5.B.9, which states when an exemption is granted:

“individual whose religious beliefs prohibit or restrict medical attention, nor shall any part of these rules be construed to compel any person, either on behalf of himself or his child or ward, to submit to any physical examination, or immunization if such person, parent, or guardian relies in good faith on spiritual means alone through prayer to prevent or cure disease or suffering and objects to the same in writing.” (MSR) 144c208 5.B.9

If you fall under the exemption, we need the parent or legal guardian to have this form filled out.
